Prophetic Names of Christ found in Isaiah 9:6




His Name in Symbols

Although many fundamental denominations, including Baptists, typically have not used many religious symbols in churches (except for the Cross), other denominations frequently use these symbols described below.


SLIDE 1: What looks like an x and p are the Greek letters “chi” (the x) and “rho” (the p). These two are the first two letters in the Greek name for Christ (the box with red letters). It has been a long tradition in some Christian groups to combine these two letters in some form to create a symbol of Christ.



SLIDE 2: The fish symbol and the Greek word for fish (ἰχθύς; pronounced “ich-thoos”) forms an acrostic so that each letter is the first letter of the phrase “Jesus Christ God’s Son, Savior.” Since many English speaking people do not recognize this symbol, the more common use is to put the name *Jesus* inside the fish symbol.



SLIDE 3: What looks as the English letters “HIS” are actually the first three letters of Jesus in Greek (the box of red letters; using all capital letters). Because people do not recognize this Greek symbol, “IHS” has commonly become a symbol that means “In His Service.”
